## TREASURER'S REPORT

  - Overview of income and expense items amount projected comes from historical budgets from years past or from discussion with the principal regarding the school's need this year

## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- iPads bought last year (about 60 total from the PAC and thru the district program) have been received in classrooms bringing primary classes to 7 iPads each and intermediate classes 6 iPads each
- The ministry is conducting its Capital Management Inventory inspectors were around the school to check the building last week
- Kids will be doing hip hop this November (sponsored by the PAC)
- December will be busy with Young Entrepreneur Fair, Gingerbread Houses (icing sponsored by the PAC), Winter Concert, Pancake Breakfast.
  - Question of whether the school administration would consider an evening Christmas concert next year? Would allow for working parents in the school community to attend. The exec team will discuss with the administration and report back at the next meeting.

## HOT LUNCH REPORT

- Term 1 has been going really well with vendors and with volunteers. Financially on track to meet projected figures.
- Term 2 online ordering will open the middle of January. There will be a change in vendor for sushi day. Parents will be surveyed in May regarding existing vendors and pricing to see if any other changes should be made for the 2020-2021 school year.
- In an effort to reduce waste, starting in Term 2 the PAC will be encouraging all kids to bring their own cutlery (forks and chopsticks) for hot lunch. Ideas to encourage this change have included: classroom contest on who brought the most (like walk/ride/roll) or a fundraiser for school branded forks with children's name.

- Jessica looking into options of giving feedback to MountainWest, trying another company like LifeTouch for a family photo night, and other options.
  - Lifetouch provides many differences to MountainWest: different contemporary backgrounds, different poses (standing/sitting), ID card provided and student pictures

stored in emergency database in case of emergency situation (lost child), cost slightly higher (approx \$5 on packages), school receives 1 free banner each year for events.

 Jessica will confirm class photos, school-wide photo, and yearbook compatibility is also included and will make proposal for change to Mrs Shergill. Voted unanimously in favour to switch (11 members in attendance).
