PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:

- Update from Principal Jane Forbes
- Painting of the interior of the school is going well a challenge to paint while students are at school
- 30 families are signed up for Kindergarten for 2022/2023 Welcome to K program was May 26th
- 68 grade 7 students will be departing Bayridge this year, making room for the students that are on Bayridge's waitlist to be offered a placement
 - Bayridge cannot accommodate more portables so students need to leave to make room for new students
- The first track meet had to be cancelled on May 20th and has been rescheduled for June 2nd
- The school calendar is very full of field trips over the next month
- Sports Day June 3rd will look a bit different than previous years but parents are welcome to attend

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- School-wide event cheque written from Gaming Account to cover invoice:
 - Hip Hop \$2016.00
- Hot Lunches Website hosting cheque to be written to ensure site is ready for PAC next year
 - o \$315 early bird rate
- Hot Lunch Term 1 Refunds offered due to covid in January were not all used for Term 2 ordering –
 13 accounts still have credits Chair will email to ask if they would donate or if they want money refunded
 - o Treasurer reports refunds can be issued through the online system direct to the credit card
- Current Treasurer and Chair have completed Gaming Grant application for next year (due June 30)
 - Discussion and questions about eligible uses of the gaming grant
- Hot Lunch Care and Concern costs influx in families needing this help and increase in total coast and we are over budget on this item considerations for next year:
 - o Increase the budget?
 - Can order a main dish only?
 - Discussion about care and concern cost report
 - Members felt that increasing budget slightly to accommodate the students that require the assistance and still give them a choice of entrée, side and drink would be best
 - Chair will include this information on the budget hand-off to the new PAC members for next year

CURRENT PAC BUSINESS

Income:

- Art Cards \$578.09 profit
 - 820 cards, 10 puzzles, 11 plaques, 14 ornaments
 - revenue is down from the last few years (\$888.98 in 2021, \$1400.20 in 2020, \$883.84 in 2019)
 - Recommendation to either give this fundraiser a break for next year or request that teachers try to do more guided art for next year (many did already but the classes that were able to create their own art did not have the sales that we saw in the guided art classrooms)

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- Spring fundraiser did not go ahead as planned
 - Discussion around Conflict of Interest
 - The Idea: Parents with a business would run fundraiser through their own website and donate sales to the school
 - Parent at our school and thus technically part of the PAC membership
 - The Problem according to the DPAC Code of Conduct: One parent in a position of financial gain.
 - The issue is equality. If this is offered as a fundraiser we would need to include any parent business possible idea to do a Fair

Expenses:

- Staff appreciation final thank you to staff in June sometime Peace Arch Nurseries conact
 Mandeep said they would be able to discuss options
 - Chair will make contact with Mandeep to arrange (possible third week of June after grade 7 events)
- Sports Day Rest Station and Treat will be provided by PAC
 - Jen got Juice Boxes already \$180.88 will be reimbursed to Jen
 - Marsha will be in charge of freezies and freeze in her facility cost TBD

Yearbooks:

- Sales thus far 108 total as of Thursday morning
- Deadline Saturday May 28th reminder will go out in Principal's newsletter and from PAC email
- With the profits 5 books can be purchased (one for each of the 4 students who won the art contest and one for the school office)
- Principal's account can be used at the Principal's discretion to purchase books for students needing Care and Concern

Grade 7 Year End:

- Fundraising has gone really well thanks to all who participated in the Frozen Treat Fridays!
- Sports Day Concession discussion about additional funds for grade 7 decision that a concession will not be offered this year. All students will receive juice and freezies from the PAC at Sports Day.
- Grade 7 Dates: June 10th (4pm-6pm students only), June 17th (field trip to beach day organized by Mr Murti), June 22 (farewell ceremony at assembly)
