2. Principal's Report:

Enrolment Update:

Currently, there are 382 students enrolled at Bayridge.

Athletics:

- Soccer wrapped up last Wednesday, and the focus has now shifted to Volleyball.

3. Treasurer's Report:

Review of the 2023-2024 school year financial report which is attached below.

The report shows an actual shortfall of \$9,326.49, and the reasons are: During the school year, we noticed a significant balance in the gaming account, primarily due to unspent funds from the Surrey School District's Gaming Grant that had accumulated over the pandemic years. In the 2023-2024 school year, these funds were used for school-wide activities under "the fund to school club." Since the Gaming Grant balance was not reflected in the report's INCOME section, it led to an apparent shortfall in the financial report.

4. 2024-2025 Budget Review and Vote:

Changes of note to this years budget were increases in the amount of money given to the technology upgrade, school wide activities and field trips. As we all know, prices have increased substantially in past few years. As a result of the price increases, PAC has increased funding in these areas to ensure that Bayridge students have best learning experience possible! All details can be seen in the approved budget for this year.

- The proposed budget for the 2024-2025 school year was reviewed (see attached budget document).
- The motion was unanimously approved by all attendees.

5. Fundraisers:

Pop-up Sales:

- Last year's Pop-up Sales were highly successful, not only raising funds but also energizing the school atmosphere. This year, the Pop-up Sales will focus on selling donuts, hot chocolate before Christmas, and freezes during spring and summer.
- The PAC will coordinate with the 7th grade to avoid scheduling conflicts and ensure both events run smoothly.

The motion was unanimously approved by all attendees.

Joint Grade 7 Pub Night:

- PAC is excited to partner with the Grade 7s to host a pub night for parents. The goal is to raise money that will be split 50/50 between PAC and the Grad 7 graduation fund. Please watch for details regarding this event that will be released in one of the upcoming PAC newsletters!!
- Pub Night is scheduled for February-April 2025.
- The motion was unanimously approved by all attendees.

Spirit Wear:

- There have been many requests for spirit wear to be sold this year. There will be a samples placed in the entrance of the school that can be used for sizing reference. There are some cool new styles that are currently being finalized. An email will be sent out in the very near future for this event.
- The PAC is launching a Spirit Wear fundraiser featuring Bayridge-branded Tshirts.
- The orders will be set up before Christmas.

- This event involves selling pre-packaged cookie dough to raise funds for school programs. It's planned as a Christmas fundraising event, providing an easy and fun way for the school community to contribute.

Purchasing of Pop-up Tents:

 PAC is excited to announce the purchasing of pop up tents for Bayridge Elementary. PAC is providing these tents to ensure the health and well being of all Bayridge students. Our hopes is that the pop up tents will be used for
